

## Some UFO's are Aliens

Stanton Friedman, from Fredricton, is a nuclear physicist and lecturer on UFO's. He is an expert on UFO information. For about ten years he has crisscrossed the continent speaking at over 600 universities and colleges. He was a special consultant on the tv program "Unsolved Mysteries" for a UFO episode. He was technical advisor for the 1979 motion picture "UFO's are Real." He has appeared on talk shows and new shows like "Nightline." This is but a small summary of his accomplishments.

On Feb. 6 Stanton gave two lectures at the Vet College in lecture theatre A. I attended the evening lecture where I found that there were more people than there were chairs available. There must have been about 80 people there. Stanton opened his lecture with some humour, "Mary had a little lamb its fleece as white as snow and everywhere that Mary went, she saw a UFO." Stanton went on to say that "Some UFO's are aliens. Most are not. I am only concerned with the second part." Stanton acknowledged that there are plenty of sceptics but added, "5% of Americans don't even believe that we've gone to the moon. Gallup poles indicate that the majority of people seem to believe in UFO's. Stanton said, "Despite what some would expect, the greater the education a person has, the more likely they will believe in UFO's". Fear of the ridicule prevents many people from reporting UFO's sightings.

Stanton believes that both the American governments have the knowledge about UFO's which they will not release to the public. The U.S. used the excuse of "a possible threat to security" for not releasing UFO information. Stanton calls this information coverups the "Cosmic Watergate". The FBI has UFO files via the Freedom to Information Act. Even this Act has failed. Eventually the FBI did release one or two of their hundreds of files. Yet each file had 74% or more of it blocked out so that nothing important is left to read.

In July 1947, the Roswell incident occurred. Roswell, New Mexico, a UFO crashed and three aliens were found near the ship. Two of the aliens were dead and the third was dying when the military arrived. The aliens were white, with large black eyes, ears, nose and arms, but they were only about 3 feet tall. The military covered everything up and the only reason the story came out is because a CIVILIAN saw the aliens

before the military arrived. Later a mortician and Gerald Anderson testified that they had seen and touched the aliens. Stanton showed us many interesting photos and slides of UFO's and even a drawing of aliens. Stanton can be reached at 79 Pembroke Crescent Fredricton, N.B. E3B 2V1. When Stanton asked how many Islanders had seen UFO's about 20 people raised their hands which is about line 4 if there were 80 people there.
