Contract Bridge

OVERCOMING THE LEAD

Today's declarer was unlucky in the opening lead that was made against him, but he simply should have thought a little more deeply.

South dealer.
 Both sides vulnerable.

♠ 10 8 3
 ♥ A Q 5
 ♦ 7 4
 ♣ 8 5 3 2

♠ 6 5 2
 ♥ J 8 4 3

The bidding:
 South West North East
 1NT Pass 2NT Pass
 3NT Pass Pass Pass Pass

West decided to lead the diamond king, instead of a club from his long suit, and this proved to be a very good idea! South held up his diamond ace, but, since East had signalled vigorously with the ten, West continued with the queen and Jack of diamonds.

South saw that even if he could run four heart tricks and win the club finesse, he still would require two spades for the contract, West put up the spade king and promptly exited with the spade Jack—giving the enemy what would be theirs in any case, but not breaking the new suit for them.

Declarer cashed dummy's last spade, discarding his own low club, while East gave up a diamond and West meekly threw off the club four. Now, after some thought, declarer led to his own heart king, then cashed the ace and queen of hearts. His reasoning was obvious: if the heart jack dropped, he would lead directly to the club ace and cash his last heart for the fulfilling trick; if the heart jack did not come to light, he would fall back on the club finesse for his final effort.

Unfortunately, the heart jack did not drop and the club finesse failed, so South had to acknowledge defeat.

South's analysis was not quite good enough. The diamond situation was marked, since West surely would have continued that suit after taking his spade king. Thus, after cashing the spades and dummy's heart honors, South should have finessed to his own heart ten. If West could win with the jack, what of it? He would then have to lead a club up to South's major tenace.






