 is indeed well advanced.  
 It would be well, under the above circumstances, for us to keep a check on ourselves and our loved ones so that little or no time is lost between the discovery of cancer and its removal, as early cancer is curable.  
 Some points to keep in mind in cancer of colon and stomach: In cancer of colon, there is (a) abdominal pain, (b) increasing constipation, (c) passage of blood from rectum, (d) vomiting (e) diarrhoea, (f) loss of weight, (g) weakness.  
 In cancer of stomach, there is (a) feeling of discomfort over stomach, disappearing at night; (b) belching of gas and distension, (c) loss of appetite, (d) pain after meals, (e) tiredness, (f) loss of weight, (g) thin blood.

**LOBSTER REVENUE UP**—Although Island fishermen this year suffered serious loss of gear, their receipts were over \$100,000 more than they were for 1952, states Mr. J. J. Larabe, Fisheries supervisor. The lobster catch last year was 68,911 cwt. with a value to the fisherman of \$1,481,944, compared to this year's catch of 54,230 cwt. with a landed value of \$1,562,162, shows a drop in weight of 14,000 cwt. but an increase in value of \$100,218. The increase in revenue is due to the higher prices paid for both cannery and markets. The greater part of the harvest was sold at the latter part of the season when the price rose to 45 cents a pound.
