Have more residence parties and invite day students. Some residents would like that, I guess.

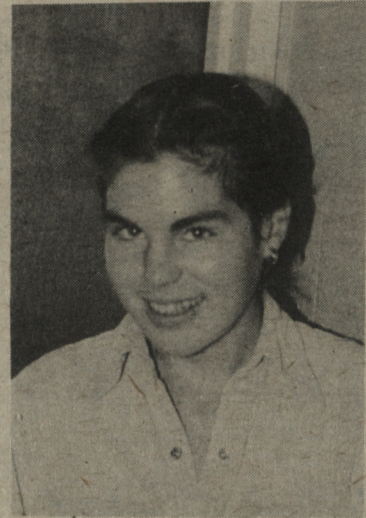


DAVID MACFADYEN - Sophomore Business

KAREN ROWELL - Sophomore Business [Bernadine Resident]

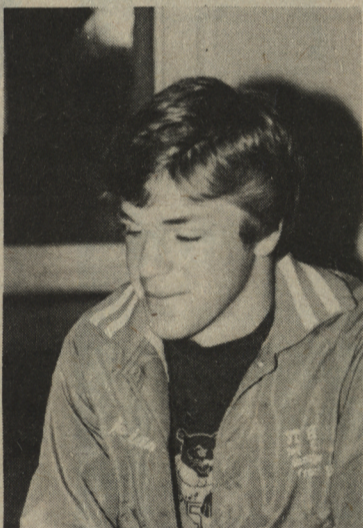
Day students don't do anything but go to class and go home.
