WINNIPEG, March 6—(CP)—The United Kingdom today was allocated 115,000 bushels of Canadian wheat but there was no other export business in wheat or coarse grains traded on Winnipeg Grain Exchange.

Coarse grains futures traded in generally narrow range and prices eased slightly.

Oats trading was limited to commercial orders from shippers and shipping interests also were buying in a small way. There was some American demand for oats.
