That is it for now but GOOD LUCK ON YOUR MONEY MATTERS!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

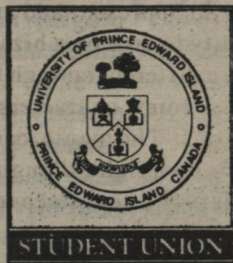
