Subject to the authority of God does not destroy spontaneity and creativeness... it makes it truly possible. Without God, man can do nothing.

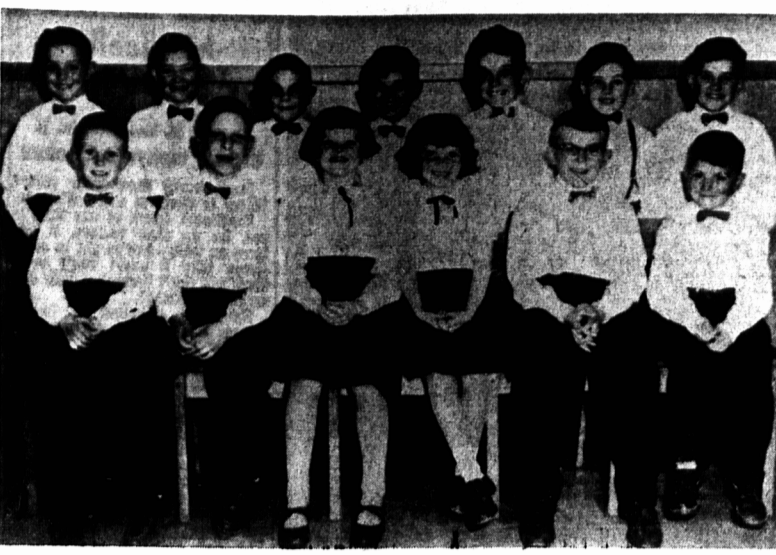
