The Indianapolis 500

FOR THE PAST 20 years the Offenhauser engine has shown supremacy in motor car racing unparalleled by any other weapon in sporting history.

The high compression Offenhauser (Offie), a four-cylinder off-shoot of the Harry Miller 8's that had been developed in the 1920's to stop the powerful Duesenbergs, was first driven to victory at Indianapolis in 1924 by Bill Cummings.

Only three times since then has the Offie been beaten—in 1929 and 1940 by Wilbur Shaw in Maserati 8's and in 1946 by Tony George's 8-cylinder car handled by George Robson. A few years ago the entire field at Indianapolis was made up of Offenhauser revised cars.

Saturday however, for the first time since its super-powered development, the Offie is expected to get a serious challenge from a new breed—the rear-engine-mounted Lotus Ford.

At last year's 500-mile event Jim Clark of Scotland came through with the Lotus 49's first serious challenge, finishing second, only 31 seconds behind Clark's Offie.

Clark, the world race driving champion, had his 8-cylinder pushed engine mounted in the rear. A second Lotus-Ford handled by Dan Gurney of California finished seventh.

The Age Of The Lotus-Ford

THE SURPRISING performance by the Lotus-Fords set off a chain reaction of rear-mounted engine construction. The Lotus-Fords have proved that lighter-weight machines burning unleaded gasoline—instead of the mixture used by the Offie—could go farther on a tankful and make the fire wear negligible.

The Offenhauser had to make three stops during the race. The Lotus-Ford could do it on one.

The Fords are based on the widely known passenger car Fairlane engine. The Offie, rear and front, have four cylinders.

The race will have at least two new cars with the noted 8-cylinder Novi engines. One of the 8-cylinder Novis will be used, center mounted, in a four-wheel drive racer built by Ferguson.

Although they have never won the Indianapolis since first introduced there in the early 1930's, the Novis are popular because of their powers.

The Indianapolis race, first run for 500 miles in 1911, was created by a group of automotive pioneers in an effort to popularize their products.

It was one of the first of a series of races, first used and of other accessories such as the rear-view mirror, first used on a car by Ray Harroun, as the victor of the first race. As time passed many 4-cylinder cars were raced on the 2 1/2 mile speedway.
