## Monster parade opens carnival

SUMMERSIDE — A mammoth parade beginning at 1:30 on the afternoon of July 11 will mark the opening of the 11th annual Lobster Carnival and Livestock Show to be held here from July 11 to 16.

Lobster Carnival directors are confident that this year's parade will provide enjoyment for all ages, both young and old alike. It is anticipated that this year's parade will feature 30 floats, eight bands, along with a number of marching units.

Acclaimed by critics as one of the best on the East Coast, the EMCS Stadacona band will be arriving here Monday morning to take part in the parade.

Of special interest to Islanders will be the Summerside Presbyterian Church Pipe Band Formed in 1963, the 23 member band is under the direction of Byron Bruce and Donald Groom, both Summerside residents.

The newly organized Ladies Slipper Square Club formed here in January will add a touch of zest to the parade with a number of dancers gaily dancing to old time tunes.

Along with this new addition to the parade there will be a

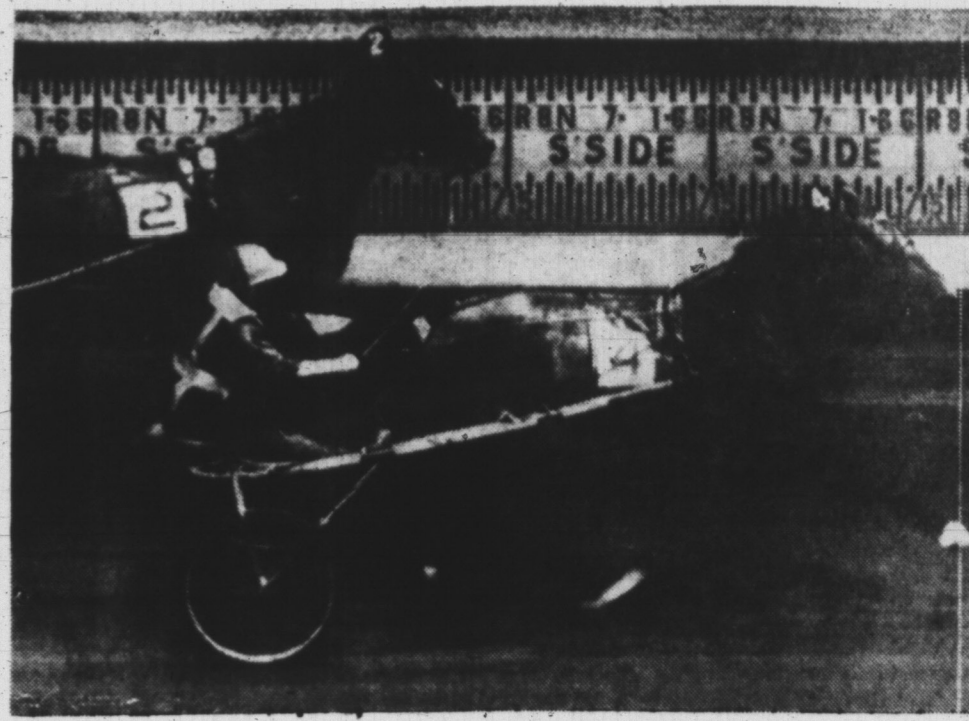
large number of other floats sure to capture the eye.

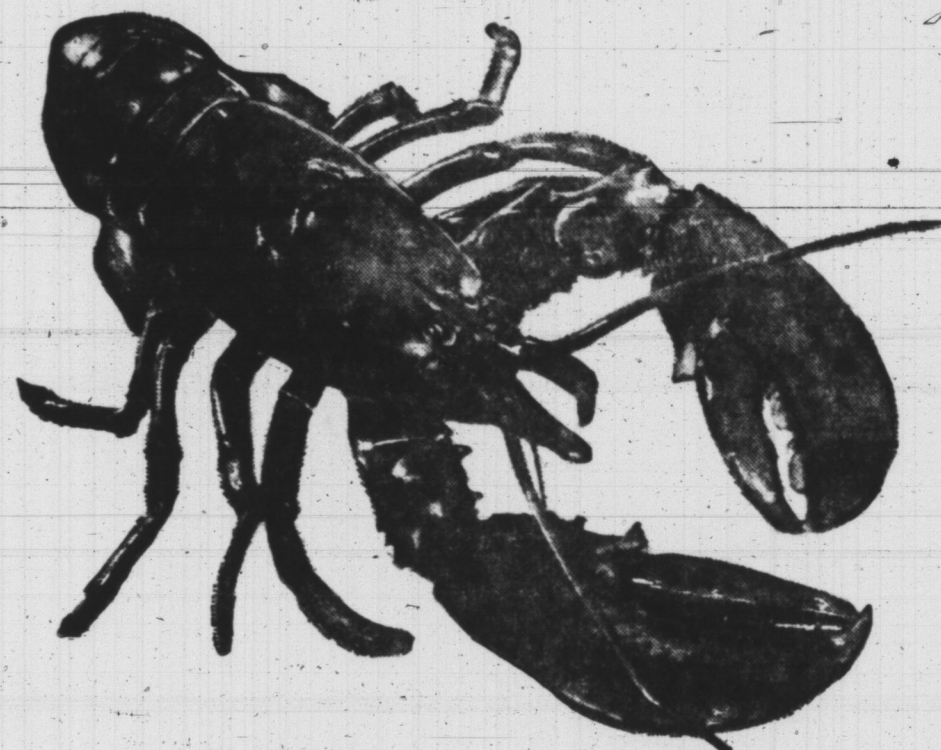

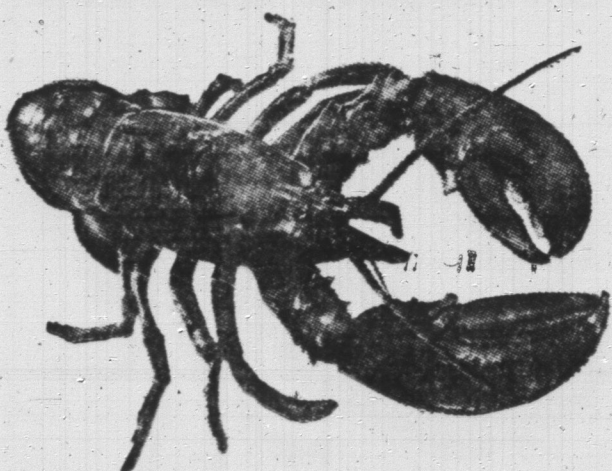

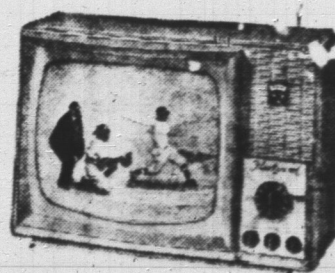
