

# Glenfinnan Man Dies In Accident

John D. MacDonald, 44, son of Senator J. J. MacDonald of Glenfinnan was killed in a two-car collision near Fullerton's Bridge, four miles from Charlottetown, about 12.10 early Friday morning. The other victim, Gerald Lawrence Smith of Donagh was taken to the Charlotte-

town Hospital with undetermined injuries. A spokesman for the hospital said the 18-year-old youth is resting comfortably. His condition is not serious. Dr. C. A. Coady is the attending physician.

## BOTH CARS SMASHED

The fact that both vehicles received damage to their left front grills and fenders especially, indicated that they hit almost head-on, police said. The MacDonald car came to rest facing west while the Smith automobile was pointing south-

west. The MacDonald car was a 1955 Mercury driven by Mr. Smith received extensive damage to the left front and side portions of the car, which came to rest across the highway facing south.

## HIGHWAY BLOCKED

The highway at this point, approximately 285 yards west of Fullerton's Bridge was impassable because of the Smith vehicle which blocked the roadway. However, two towing services from the city arrived and freed the motionless traffic.

Frank Dalton of Fort Augustus told a reporter that he was the first at the scene. He said there was no response from either driver so he rushed to the nearest farm house and summoned an ambulance.

Cutcliffe's Ambulance service received the call and took both victims to the Charlottetown Hospital.

Meanwhile, at the accident scene, RCMP Constables A. H. Bennett and I.W. Oland were taking measurements and also

## Recommend Cutting Ch'town School Year

The feeling that it is sufficient and advisable to close schools in the last full week of June was expressed at the recent annual meeting of St. Jean Elementary Home and School.

A resolution recommending to the Department of Education that the minimum number of days in the school year be reduced to 180 was adopted.

The principal, J.R. MacDonald, noted in his report that June tends to be a month of high pressure and tension with final exams, promotion etc., all concentrated at this time. He expressed hope that June might soon be like any other month by making promotion a continuous process with different rating for different children. The children would then pick up in September where they left off in June.

It was decided that the selection of one student to be sponsored by the association at the Columbia Cultural Centre would be made by a committee composed of the principal and teachers.

Money was voted for school prizes and for the school library. In giving his report the president, George Hoad, noted the stress placed on practical programs of interest and importance to the school and home.

Officers elected for the coming year include: president, Bill Ledwell; vice-president, Gus Campbell; secretary, treasurer, Steve Connolly, Jr. The committee for organizing swimming instruction was also appointed under the direction of Mrs. Chinery.



