

must send to NSERC by mid-June the applications and transcripts for all students who have been selected and who actually take up their awards.

2. Industrial Undergraduate Student Research Awards:

The objective of these awards is to stimulate the interest of undergraduate students in research by providing them with valuable experience in and industrial laboratory, and to encourage these students to undertake graduate studies. Eligibility is similar to the above award section. For the duration of the award, a student will be an employee of the company at which the award is held. Awards are normally tenable during the summer months with a maximum of four month duration. Application forms are available from the UPEI department heads.

10. Petro Canada Awards for Native Students:

- A. Open
- B. Petro Canada Inc. is offer-

ing up to five(5) education awards each year to post-secondary students of Canadian Indian or Inuit ancestry. The purpose is to encourage and to assist Native individuals to complete advanced educational studies which may be applied in an industrial setting (Petro Canada itself and the oil and gas industry in general). Each application will be considered using such criteria as: financial need, academic performance and potential, the appropriateness of the discipline of studies to industry, and future aspirations.

C. The awards are designed to cover all or part of tuition, textbooks, supplies and the student's living expenses during the course of the academic year. The maximum amount of the award is \$5000.00 per year depending on the financial needs of the student.

D. Students are requested to apply for the Petro Canada Education Award through the awards office at their post-secondary institution.

11. Pillsbury Undergraduate Scholarship Program:

The purpose of the Pillsbury Undergraduate Scholarship Program is to encourage scholastic achievement and development in areas which are of primary concern to Pillsbury Canada Limited. Two awards of \$1250.00 will also be given to students of Business/Commerce and two awards of \$1250.00 will also be given to students of Food Sciences and Agricultural Science. This program is open to all faculties of Business/Food Science/Agricultural Science at Canadian Universities. Four university scholarships are awarded annually.

Eligibility is limited to students who have completed their second full year of study towards their undergraduate year. Evaluation will be based on the student's academic transcripts as well as participation in extra-curricular activities. Completed applications are to be sent di-

rectly to the Scholarship Selection Committee not later than Nov. 30.

12. University Of Ottawa Undergraduate Research Scholarships:

These scholarships would be of interest to students presently registered in the 2nd or 3rd year of a Science or Engineering Bachelor's degree (including Experimental Psychology and Physical Geography).

The University of Ottawa is offering Summer Research Scholarships to Canadian and permanent resident students who are enrolled full-time in an undergraduate programme. These awards will provide research experience with leading scientific investigators in one of the fields listed below.

The value is \$1200.00 (minimum)/month plus a travel allowance. The duration of the program is 3-4 months from May - August. The applicant must have an application in to the university by November 13, as well as a reference from one professor sent to the university with the same deadline.

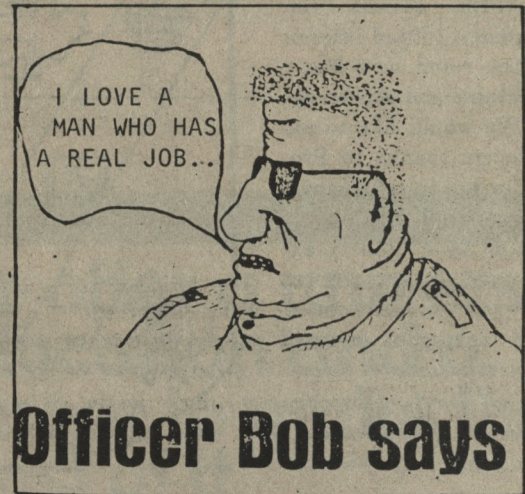
