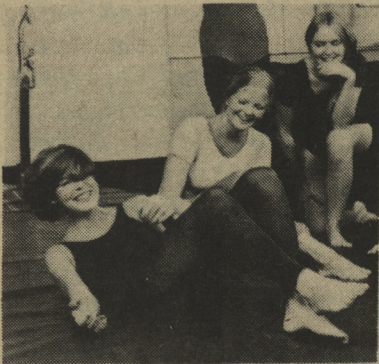


## HIGH SCHOOL VISITATION PROGRAMME
