

# Overhaul Is Promised For Labor Legislation

QUEBEC (CP)—Quebec labor legislation is to get an overhaul through the legislature session opening next week Premier Paul Sauve said Wednesday.

He made the announcement to delegates of the Quebec Federation of Labor (C.L.C.) which presented its annual brief to the provincial cabinet.

Mr. Sauve said many reforms sought by labor unions would be proposed in the legislature. He declined to disclose details of his legislative program but said the following items are due for changes.

1. The labor relations board: its make-up would be modified; its jurisdiction status clarified and the legal machinery set up for its operations would be changed. The government would take steps to end labor complaints the board takes too long to make decisions.

2. The minimum wage act: The minimum wage now set would be revised upwards. This act is administered by a government commission. By 1958 it had jurisdiction over 46,000 employers employing 1,000,000 persons.

3. The superior council of labor: This 30-man body which acts in an advisory capacity to the labor department has been inactive for some years. Its last official act was to propose a draft labor code to the provincial government. The late premier Duplessis shelved the project. The council is made up of employer, employee and government representatives and experts on social matters.

The labor federation said in its brief one of the basic union rights most frequently violated is the right of association.

The government leader said that under his administration there is no threat to the right of association.

**RIGHT TO STRIKE**  
The federation asked for the right to strike on behalf of public services employees.

Mr. Sauve said strikes are a last resort for ending industrial disputes. Strikes should not be resorted to until all methods of conciliation have been exhausted.

The labor group said the Quebec-provincial police has a bad reputation in union circles.

Mr. Sauve said that police are sent in an area only at the request of local authorities elected by the people to administer.

"It all depends from what angle you look at this matter," he said. As for the labor relations board make-up, Mr. Sauve said he is in favor of equal representation of both employers and labor unions.

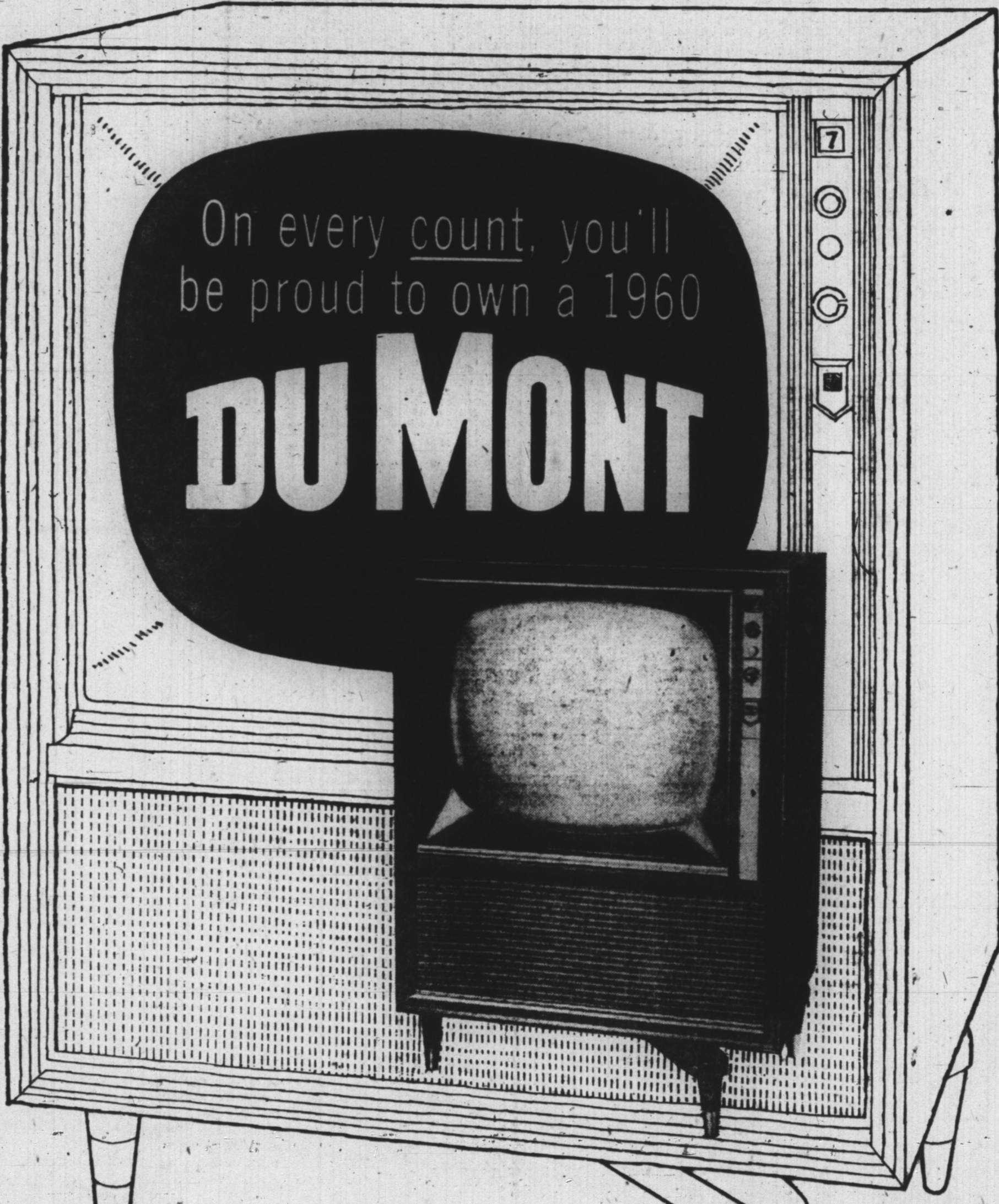

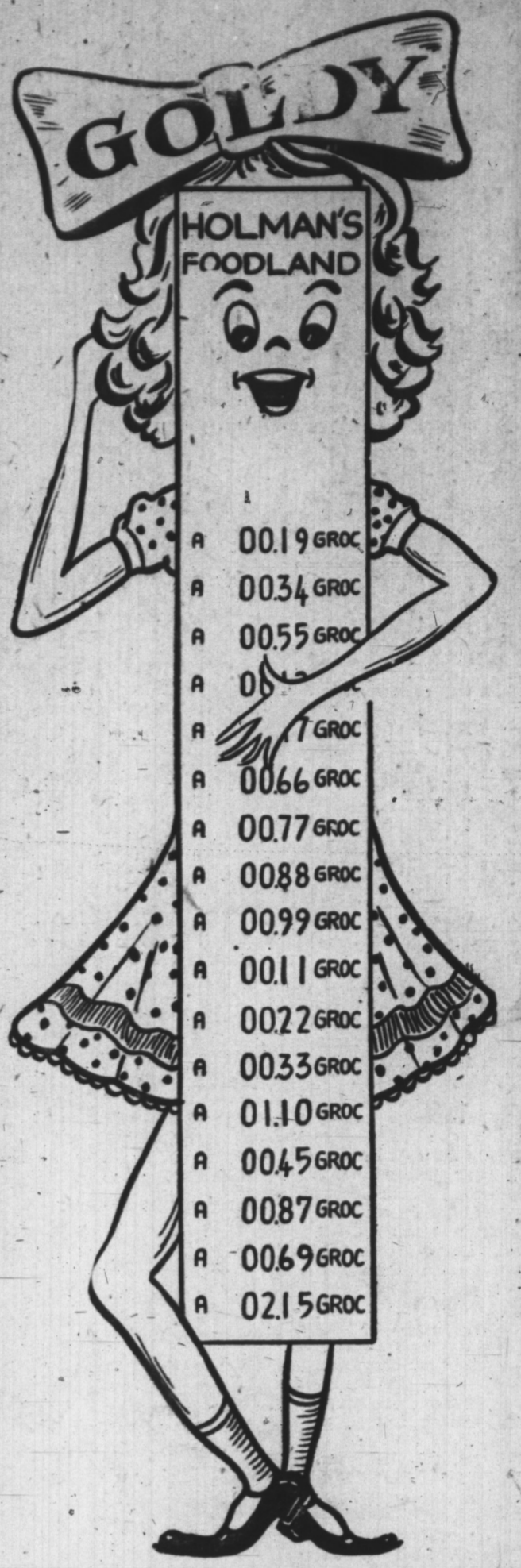
