Walter Gordon Is Opposed By Liberal Policy Paper

OTTAWA (CP) - A background paper for the Liberal party's conference here Oct. 10-12 lines up solidly against prime minister's arguments of Walter Gordon in the party's strenuous debate over economic philosophy.

Criticism of Mr. Gordon's job as finance minister between 1963 and 1965 is also implied in the paper prepared by David W. Slater, editor of The Canadian Banker and former adviser to several royal commissions.

Mr. Slater discounts many of Mr. Gordon's concerns over foreign investment. Without mentioning names, he says that "some current arguments" have "the same misleadingly over-simplified theories of governments as the puppets of tightly-knit power elites composed of business and the military."

"The evidence does not support the contentions that Canada experiences greater instability in production and employment as a result of her foreign investment relations, nor that Canada's exports have been, on balance, reduced, nor that type of production, production methods and industrial structure in Canada have been made inappropriate due to foreign investment; nor that the 'piling back' of profits has been reduced by foreign investment."

The paper says available evidence gives "not all that much support" to claims that foreign ownership and control are concentrated in high-output, high-profit areas of the economy.

WANT SHOCK ABSORBER - Withdrawal of foreign capital could cause shocks, but its availability had also acted as a shock absorber.

Mr. Slater also deals specifically with Mr. Gordon's concern about loss of political sovereignty.

"The Canadian government has enormous power, greater power than it had in the past, over foreign and Canadian companies operating in Canada.

"Canada has a more diversified than in the past, partly due to the foreign investment, and a greater wealth, Canada has a more highly skilled citizenry, more than 100 years of responsible government, a reputation for fair dealing even with repatriating foreign equity investments in Canada and a highly-
