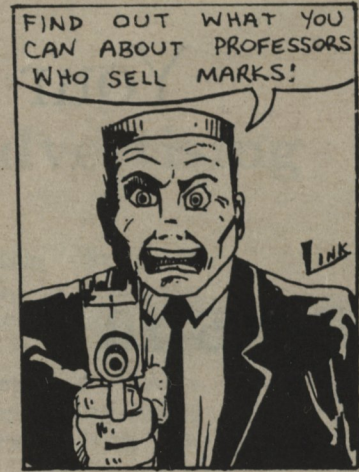

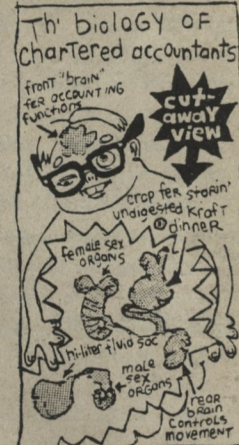

Justice MacDonald has been a member of the Board of Governors since 1983.
