It will be her first operatic role here or anywhere.

Quebec Loses On Tobacco Tax

QUEBEC, (CP)—The Quebec government will lose about \$3,000,000 in tobacco taxes this year as a result of a cigaret price-war wage chiefly by large Montreal and Quebec chain stores, a government spokesman said Tuesday.

The chain stores have been selling the cigarets at 33 cents for a pack of 20 compared with 37 cents in most retail outlets.

The spokesman said the government's loss results from the fact that chain stores base a 1-per-cent tobacco tax on a sale price of 30 cents a pack.

He said the situation is affecting the business of the mass of small tobacco retailers in the province.

There can be no question of cancelling licences of large chain stores, he said, since they do not have and do not require tobacco selling licences.

"Only wholesalers have special licences to sell tobacco because wholesalers collected the provincial tax on tobacco."

Large chain stores buy their tobacco supplies from the companies directly, he added.

The spokesman indicated that if the sale of cigarets at cut prices is not stopped the government will probably seek some special way to prevent it.

The tobacco tax in Quebec for the 1953-54 fiscal year yielded \$12,734,162.

around the heart is sewed up and the wound closed. The patient is given oxygen continuously, during and following the operation, for 24 to 48 hours. As a rule, he is able to leave the hospital within a week to ten days.

The principle of this operation is that the talc powder produces some inflammation of the pericardium surrounding the heart, which aids in building up new circulation to the heart muscle. Many patients with coronary artery disease have been operated on in this way with excellent results.

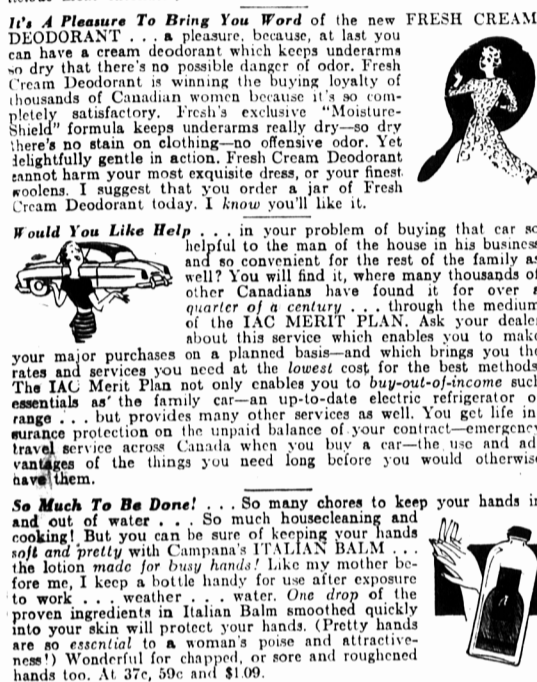
