BOND MARKETS

TORONTO (CP) - Prices were mixed in moderate trading on the Canadian bond market this week.

Short-term Canada issues advanced last week with the 3 1/2-per-cent, May 1, 1966, issue closing at 99.70 bid and 99.80 asked.

Treasury bills were higher in yield with the 91-day and the 182-day bills closing 4.60 and 4.90 per cent.

Long-term issues were lower with the 5 1/4-per-cent, May 1, 1990, issue closing at 99 1/2 bid and 99 3/4 asked.

Day-to-day money closed at 3 1/2 per cent. The amount available was \$208,000,000 compared with \$194,000,000 last week.

Provincials fell slightly with the 5 1/4-per-cent, March 1, 1966, closing at 89 1/2 bid and 89 3/4 asked.

Corporate and municipal trading was quiet with few price changes.
