PUBLIC OPINION ON TRIAL.

Hon. Geo. E. Foster has put the case against the Ottawa Government thus:

"They promised to reduce the debt—they have increased it by over six millions.

"To cut down expenditures—they are now ten millions greater.

"To take off the grinding load of taxation—they have collected seven millions more.

"To destroy protection—they have adopted it in principle and practice.

"To abolish railway subsidies—they have voted ten millions in the two sessions.

"To guarantee Parliamentary independence—the Premier over his own signature writes letters to sitting members promising judgeships, governorships and subsidies.

"To conserve purity of elections—they condone ballot-stuffing and ballot-stealing and give high offices to those who run the 'machine.'

"They enticed the temperance vote with promises of a plebiscite and accordant legislation; but made a secret arrangement five years before the vote which renders any successful outcome for the temperance people absolutely impossible.

"Now when taxed with bad faith they stand up in the full light of day and either tell you with a brazen effrontery, 'we have redeemed every pledge,' or, with a wink and a smart look, say as Sir Wilfrid said in the House of Commons, 'Well, what are you going to do about it? We are here and you are there.'

"It seems to me that with such men and such acts the honest and intelligent electorate of Canada may be safely trusted to deal.

"Public opinion in Canada, now, as never before, is on trial, and I firmly believe that it may be fully trusted to work out its own vindication."
