## Recover Cattle

BRISBANE, Australia (CP)—Police who have impounded 7000 head of cattle hope to smash the biggest gang of rustlers in Queensland's history.

The gang, believed to be of eight to 10 men, has stolen cattle from some of the state's best known ranches, covering many thousands of square miles.

The cattle from the outer fringes of the ranches were driven up to 100 miles to secret ravines.

Instead of stealing only unbranded calves in the traditional Australian rustling style, the thieves drove off branded beasts, then burned new brands over the old and cut off ear-marks.

Polled who have impounded 7000 number stolen by the gang over the last 12 months runs into thousands.
