### GUEST SPEAKERS

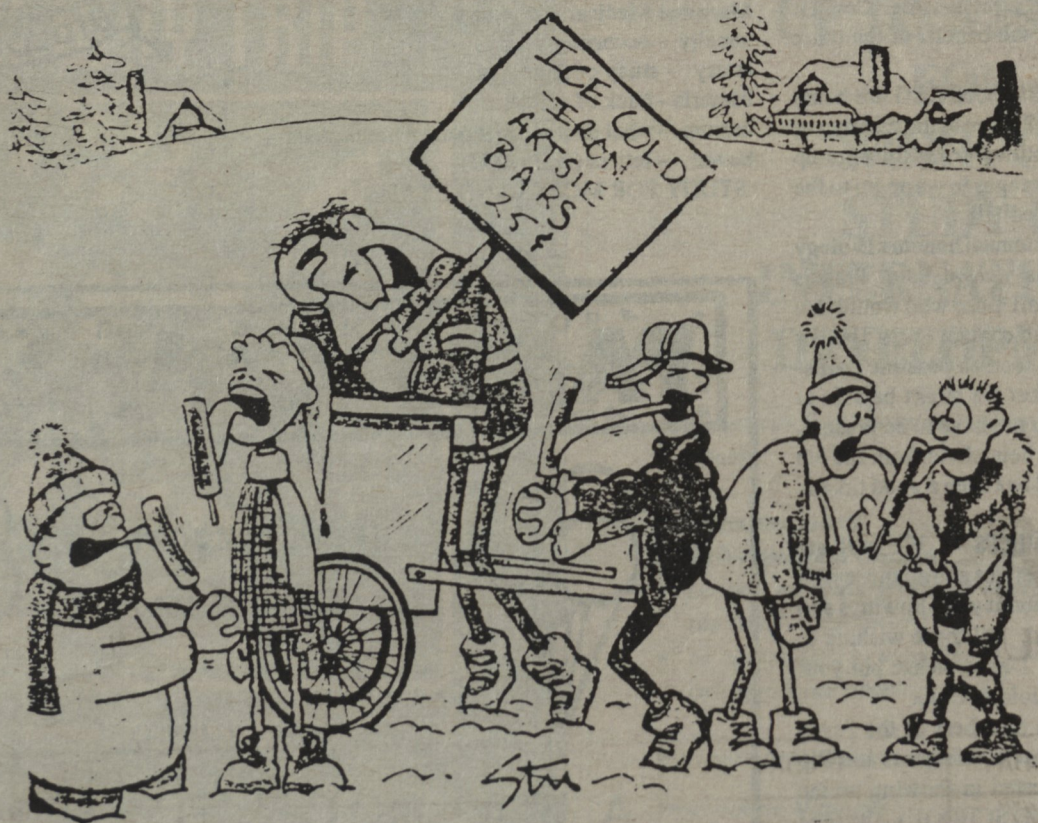
