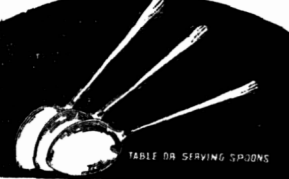
RICH DARK CHOCOLATE CAKE

STRAWBERRY RAPTURE

1 pint of sliced fresh strawberries
3/4 cup sugar
2 tablespoons white corn syrup
1 teaspoon gelatin
2 tablespoons water
1 cup heavy cream
1/2 teaspoon lemon juice
Allow strawberries to stand with sugar poured over them for 15 or 20 minutes; heat over low heat until sugar has dissolved. Add syrup and gelatin which has been softened in water. Cool, and fold in cream which has been whipped to a soft custard consistency; add lemon juice. Pour ice cream mixture into tray from refrigerator; return tray to chilling unit and freeze at coldest point until mixture is of the right consistency to serve. Serves 8. Put ice cream into sherbet glasses and garnish with green leaves and a fresh strawberry.

BLANKETS

Washing Blankets

Wet blankets should be handled lightly because the wool fibre is made less strong by water. Hang them evenly on the line, lengthwise, using plenty of pins and putting half the blanket on one side and half on the other. Carefully stretch the corners and pull the edges straight, taking care not to stretch the blanket in any place. If it is brushed with a clean, soft whisk broom when thoroughly dry it will be more fluffy. Do not dry woolens in the sun.
