Bishop's U To Honor Six

LENNOXVILLE, Que. (CP)—Bishop's University will confer honorary degrees to six prominent Canadians including Lieutenant Chevrier, Canada's high commissioner to the United Kingdom, at its annual convocation May 30, it was announced Thursday.

Mr. Justice C. D. Abbott, chancellor of the university, said the degrees of doctor of civil law will also be conferred on Norman Robertson, under-secretary of state for external affairs; Most Rev. Alexander Henry O'Neil, Anglican archbishop of Fredericton and metropolitan of the ecclesiastical province of Canada; W. Earle McLaughlin, president of the Royal Bank of Canada; James B. Woodruff, former chairman of the board of the Southern Canada Power Company; and Lt.-Col. W. W. Ogilvie, Montreal philanthropist and member of the university corporation's executive committee.
