## Profit Reports Helped Boost Stocks At N.Y.

NEW YORK (AP)—A great flood of excellent corporate profit reports turned the stock market ahead last week.

One large corporation after another reported record high first quarter earnings, and many took highly favorable dividend action. Some, didn't do so well, but they were overruled in the welter of favorable reports.

Looking into the future, many companies saw only a continuation of their present prosperous situation, and they geared their spending on expansion to that condition.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks advanced \$1.50 to close at \$19.22 net of Canada. Dial 8506.

**CONSOLIDATION PERIOD**

For the last three weeks the market has been going through a period of consolidation characterized by irregularly lower markets for the most part.

From where the market stands now, many brokers believe it would be easy to resume the old advance with enough force to establish record highs again. That belief is based on a number of technical signs which the market has been giving to technicians.

Aluminum Ltd., last week gained 4 1/2 points to 124, last week announced a \$250,000 program for a new hydroelectric project on the Peribonka river in northern Quebec to produce a minimum of 150,000 of aluminum a year.

The company's subsidiary, Aluminum Company of Canada Ltd., is negotiating with the Quebec government for rights to develop the power site, about 80 miles from Isle Malgise.

Also higher on the big board were: Granby Mining, up 1/2 to 17 1/2; Hudson Bay Mining, up 1/2 to 71; International Nickel, up 1/2 to 83 1/2; Walker-Gooderham, up 1/2 to 71.

On the American stock exchange, Brazilian Traction advanced 3/4 to 7; Canadian Marconi to 5 1/2; Shawinigan Mines 3/4 to 79; Oil denite 116 to 1 1/2; and Fargo Oil denite 116 to 1 1/2.

U. S. Steel Mills Break All Records

CLEVELAND (AP)—For the second straight week, steel mills in the United States broke all-time weekly production records last week, Steel Magazine reports.

A pace of 100.5 per cent of rated capacity production turned out 2,474,202 net tons of steel, the metal working weekly says.

It was the fourth time this year the mills had topped the 1955 weekly record of 2,421,000 tons set in the week ended Dec. 18.

Last Jan. 29 the mills recorded a seven-day output of 2,449,584 tons. In the week ended Feb. 19, and again in the week ended April 22, the mills produced 2,461,893 tons.

The magazine predicts record operations for the second quarter of this year.

And despite this high level, the magazine says, many forms of steel will remain difficult to get.

**SOME STEELS SHORT**

"Expected to be in short supply throughout the year are plates, standard structural shapes, wide-flange beams, seamless pipe, oil country tubular goods and possibly small sizes of hot-rolled carbon bars."

If there is no steel strike this summer, "cold-rolled carbon sheets may be easier to get as automakers work off part of the inventories being built up. But this will not affect other forms of steel in short supply."
