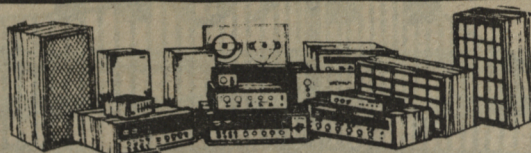

# Top Album Picks

- NEIL YOUNG-Trans, Geffen GHS 2018 (Warner Bros.). Produced by Neil Young, David Briggs, Tim Mulligan. Young's first for Geffen coincides with his boldest stylistic gamble in years, a swing toward synthesizer-laced techno-pop that treats Young's reedy voice as well as his guitars. Older fans will likely be divided over the merits of his digital conversion, making the presence of more familiar vocal and instrumental hooks on the first single, "Little Thing Called Love," an important concession to his AOR base.

- TRIO-Mercury MX1509 (PolyGram). Produced by Klaus Voorman. Dance clubs and some of the more experimental AOR and urban contemporary stations have been playing Trio's "Da Da Da," the ultimate exercise in pop minimalism, for awhile now. This six-track EP by this new German band gives new meaning to the phrase "stripped down." Surprisingly, Trio uses lots of guitar--in addition to synthesizer--to create its sound.

Group: STRANGE ADVANCE  
Title: Worlds Away

Nothing strange about this record. Although the electronic maybe described as advanced, you don't have to be a synthesizer technician to appreciate the music. This three piece band from Vancouver have released a very effective debut album that is sure to do very well on the charts.

The music, produced by Bruce Fairburn, ranges from erie sound effects on "Watermusic" to a commercial dance sound on "She Controls Me" There is even a ballad included on the top side.

If you like the new sound of the 80's, this selection is well worth adding to your collection. Choice cuts include, "Prisoner", "She Controls Me", and "Worlds Away".

Group: STRAY CATS  
Title: Built for Speed

The STRAY CATS revive the blues-rock sound that was ever so popular in America during the 50's and early 60's. Their hit single "Rock This Town" is already on the charts and promises to do even better.

Sound quality on this record is very good considering the limited instrumentation provided by the threemembers of the band. (i.e. an upright accoustical bass and a drumset consisting only of a bass-drum, snare drum and cymbal)

Rock-abilly fans should enjoy this record. "Rock This Town", "Built for Speed" and "Stray Cat Strut" are the band's best work.

Title: Hello, I Must Be Going

PHIL COLLINS, ex-drummer and vocalist from Genesis returns with a solo album

boasting a sound that is very distinctly his own. Some tracks bring back memories from his former band while others lead him off into an entirely new direction. His style ranges from very laid back to jazz flavoured dance music.

The recording quality of this record is exceptional as are the orchestral arrangements. Best materials includes " I Don't Care Anymore", and "It Don't Matter to Me"
