## IN MEMORIAM

**ERNEST L. GURNEY**  
The following is from a St. John's, P. Q. paper. The late Mr. Gurney was well known in Charlottetown and Indian River where he spent the past two summers. The death occurred on Monday, November 5th, at the St. John's Hospital, where he had been under treatment for some three weeks, of Ernest L. Gurney, long time resident and well-known citizen of St. Johns.

The late Mr. Gurney, who for several years past had been in failing health, retired after twenty-five years service with the Singer Manufacturing Company on June 1, 1948. He was at that time Purchasing Agent.  
A native of Nova Scotia he was born May 20, 1888, and was predeceased by his wife four years ago. He is survived by two brothers, Henry of Whitehall, N. Y., and Jack of Troy, N. Y.; and one sister, Mrs. Gerald (Mary) Caza, of St. Johns, with whom he had been making his home since the passing of his wife. Of a quiet, unassuming disposition, he, however made many friends and kept them. ## Brothers Keep Vintage Cars

**BURNABY, B.C. (CP)**—In the parking lot adjoining the home of Hugh and Will Silver here, are often arrayed the most splendid of late-model automobiles. The brothers scoff at them.  
Hugh and Will, sons of one of the B.C. lower mainland's pioneer auto dealers, keep in their garage and basement four old cars—one of them vintage 1913—and aver that today's gleaming roadsters cannot compare with them.  
The brothers have repaired cars in Burnaby for more than 40 years but now confine their efforts to keeping their durable models in good condition and repairing autos owned by other old-line enthusiasts.

Hugh kicked the wheel of their blocked-up 1913 Peerless, bought by their father as their mother's personal car the year it was made.

"You can't budge those wheels unless you turn the steering wheel," Hugh said approvingly. "The full reversible worm the car has makes for safer riding. No matter how big a rock you hit the steering will not be affected."  
He pointed out the tilt of the back wheels, which he said is another safety factor, along with the large size of all the wheels.  
"Take a look at this 1930 Stutz Bearcat," Hugh continued. "See the heavy bumper in front. Notice how the engine is set back from the radiator. It would take quite a lot to hurt that front end or the motor. It has hydraulic brakes and booster power brakes, too."
