Grain

WINNIPEG, Feb. 10 - (CP) - Grain prices moved lower Saturday on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange with commercial demand not aggressive.

October barley made a new seasonal low, as only light domestic shipper buying appeared in coarse grains. Other trade was light and local during the dull session.

No information was available on export loadings of Canadian wheat. Prices for L.W.A. and class two wheat were unchanged. Closing prices: Oats - May 90%, July 81A, Oct. 78%.

Suggest Oats For Hay and Pasture

Oats are particularly suited as an emergency hay and pasture crop in eastern Canada. Under normal conditions, production of pasture is during in mid and late summer. During this time many farmers find their regular pastures and aftermath inadequate for their needs.

A failure to get a good "catch" from last year seeding or severe winterkilling may cause a shortage of both hay and pasture, and an annual crop is needed to provide for expected shortages. Several reasons make oats suitable for this purpose.

The protein content of young oat plants is very high. The forage is relished by all types of livestock. Seed is usually available without any cash outlay. The chief disadvantage is that little regrowth is made after cutting for hay and heavy grazing.

For both hay and pasture a seeding rate of 2-3 bushels per acre is recommended. Successful seedings may be made up to June 15 in most areas. If all the crop is not needed for hay or pasture a part may be left to mature and be harvested for grain.

Usually grazing can be started about four to five weeks after seeding. The crop at this time should be about a foot in height. To provide more forage over a longer period, only moderate grazing is recommended so as not to cause too much damage to the plant root system.

Tests at the Central Experimental Farm, Ottawa, show that Roxton has usually outyielded most other common varieties, producing on an average of 2 1/2 tons of hay per year over a three year period.

Oats have sometimes been seeded with a number of other annual crops. For further information write the Division of Forage Plants, Central Experimental Farm, Ottawa, Ontario.
