All roads in Queens County lead to the farm of MacRae Bros. in Waterside near Pownal today for the staging of the Fifth Annual Queens County Plowing Match and its resulting competitions among many of the Island's leading plowmen.

For weeks three of main thoughts on the minds of Queens County plowmen have centered around the best crown, straightest furrow and best finish the three points on which the work of the plowmen are judged.

Its five years since the Queens County Plowing Match was inaugurated and each year the event has increased in popularity. This year under the direction of an able executive and board of directors, no effort has been spared to make the Plowing Match surpass all other events.

In addition to the plowing competitions there will be a Tractor Roado, highland step dancing competitions, junior and senior sports and 4-H Club exhibitions. Bud McMurtry of the Provincial Department of Agriculture will be in charge of the Tractor Roado.

The Tractor Roado was started at the Plowing Match three years ago under the sponsorship of the late Senator J. Walter Jones.

Top honors at the Queens County Match a year ago were taken by Stanley Willis of Cornwall. 16-year old Hilda Jones of Pownal won the ladies championship and young Carl Willis of Cornwall won the junior championship.

The Willis father and son team are expected to be back again this year to defend their titles or win new ones. They will likely be faced with plenty of competition because nearby are such outstanding plowmen as the young Morrissey brothers particularly Glen who won the Island Plowing Championship at Dundas a year ago.

There are many other outstanding plowmen expected to be present such as Sterling Moore, Malcolm MacRae, Edison Wood and Harley Ings.

A trophy for the championship plowmen has been donated by the Canadian Bank of Commerce while Douglas Bros. and Jones have donated a trophy for the junior champion. The Imperial Oil Co. Ltd. has donated free gas to all plowmen and the Island Fertilizer Co. Ltd. are graciously sponsoring a pipe band.

Plowing Match is Elliott Robertson of Pownal and the secretary treasurer is H. P. Smith also of Pownal.

One of the main cogs in the conducting of the plowing match is the plowing supervisor Robert MacRae of Waterside. His is one of the hardest, least rewarding jobs on the field for he must lay off the field and mark it. His efficient work over the years has made him a very popular figure with the plowmen.

Another woman with a very important job ahead of her is Mrs. Bennett Haywood of Charlottetown who is chairman of the Highland Dance Committee.




