Become familiar with the Interlibrary Loan service that is available to you.

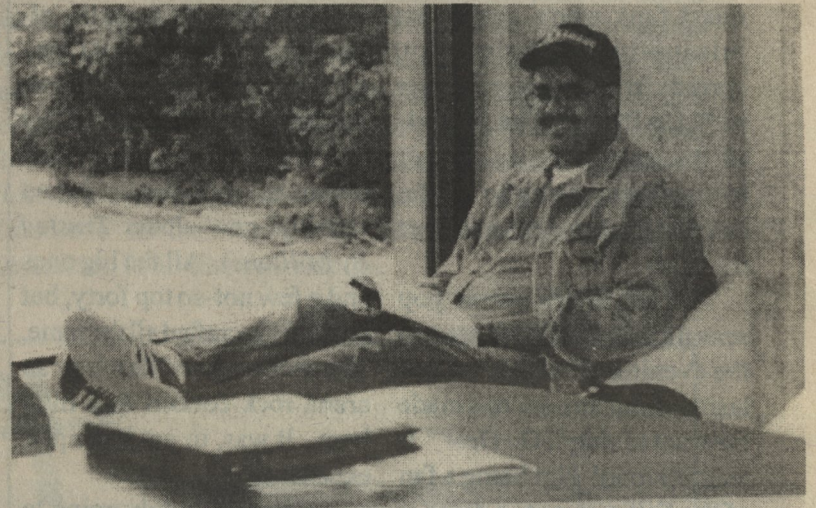
