

# Cabinet Changes Made By Lesage

QUEBEC (CP) — Cabinet changes involving four portfolios, the resignation of one cabinet minister and the appointment of one new one were announced here.

Eric Kierans moves from the post of revenue minister to health minister, Rene Levesque adds the family and social welfare portfolio to his present job as minister of natural resources and Richard Hyde becomes revenue minister.

## New Campus Is Opened At York U

TORONTO (CP) — Governor-General Vanier has officially opened the new 475-acre York campus of York University on the northwest fringe of Metropolitan Toronto.

The governor-general was assisted by provincial and civic dignitaries in the ceremony opening six university buildings, including a life sciences building, library and lecture auditorium, on the second campus of the four-year old institution.

The new concepts of education reflected in York University have proven their value and have shown that even in an age of science, the humanities may still prevail.

Referring to the group tutorial system used at York which he called "a hallmark of the British concept of a university," the governor-general said:

"It is no exaggeration to say that York University, in introducing it, places itself in the vanguard among North American institutions."

**HONOR VANIER**  
Robert Winters, former federal public works minister and chairman of the York board of governors, announced a college now under construction will be named Vanier College in honor of the governor-general.

He said the library, now in use, will be named Stacie Science Library after the late Dr. E. W. R. Stacie, long-time president of the National Research Council. The lecture hall, also in use, will be called Burton Memorial Auditorium in memory of Charles L. Burton, former president of Robert Simpson Co. Ltd. who was active in education.

York Campus now holds 450 students, including about 100 in residence. By 1970, the daytime campus population is expected to swell to 6,000 with an additional 4,000 night students.

Another 1,000 students are enrolled at York's Glendon Campus, opened in the autumn of 1968.

## J.A. Ouimet Reappointed

OTTAWA (CP) — The government has reappointed J. Alphonse Ouimet as CBC President, seeking to bring some stability to the broadcasting scene and allow time for the air to clear in the wake of the Fowler committee dust storm.

Prime Minister Pearson announced a point in time for another term for the 57-year-old CBC chief. Although his statement did not specify the length of the term, this is set out in the broadcasting act as seven years.

The announcement also noted that Dr. Andrew Stewart, chairman of the Board of Broadcast Governors, was reappointed earlier as head of that regulatory body.

## U.S. Output Of Steel Heads For New Record

CLEVELAND (AP) — Steel magazine said Sunday national steel production may set a record this year and will be just as high in 1968.

Steel bases its forecast on predictions that records will be set in passenger car output, gross national product and plant and equipment expenditures.

Steel inventories laid in as a hedge against a steelworkers' strike will be used up by early 1968, the magazine said. The 1968 forecast by the trade magazine is more optimistic than forecasts by steelmakers who are talking in terms of 120,000,000 tons. However, Steel points out that in each of the last three years, steelmaker forecasts have been "on the conservative side."

The metal working weekly said 1965 output will approximate and perhaps exceed the record 137,100,000 net tons in 1964.

Steel inventories laid in as a hedge against a steelworkers' strike will be used up by early 1968, the magazine said.

"Steel melting last week was 2,200,000 net tons, equivalent to an annual rate of 112,000,000 tons," Steel said. Through the first nine months of 1968, output totalled 103,400,000 tons compared with 92,600,000 in the comparable period of 1964, it added.

Even though inventory liquidation is under way, steel melting is only 10.5 per cent below the rate immediately prior to the steel labor settlement in early September," the magazine points out.

Tempering the decline in production shipments of steel in October "are the moderation with which cancellations and setbacks have been made by users," the magazine added.

However, reduced demand is accelerating deliveries and sharpening competition among producers, Steel said. To obtain orders, mills are offering service that was impossible during the strike hedging period. The magazine also noted a

slight easing in demand for plates, which had been extremely strong recently. The market is expected to remain strong though. Steel said, because of good business by railway equipment builders, bridge erectors, dam builders and fabricators of heavy welded pressure vessels for the petrochemical industry.

**GET RIOTOUS WELCOME**  
BURENOS AIRES (Reuters) — Isabel Peron, wife of former Argentine strongman Juan Peron, has a new address following a pitched battle between riot police and demonstrators outside her fashionable hotel Thursday. The management of the Alvear Palace Hotel said Mrs. Peron left of her own volition after the outbreak of street violence, moving to a trade union-owned hotel a few blocks away. Young anti-Peronists clashed with party stalwarts.
