South's bidding in today's deal was scarcely to be commended, but he did show considerable skill in the play.

North dealer.
East-West vulnerable.

♠ K 7	♠ 8 4 3
♥ A 8 2	♥ Q J 9 8
♦ A 6 4 3	♦ J 10 8
♣ A K 7 5	♣ Q 10 4

The bidding:

North	East	South	West
1 NT	Pass	3 ♠ (!)	Pass
2 NT	Pass	4 ♠	Pass
5 ♠	Pass	Pass	Pass

North cannot be blamed for getting slam-minded when his partner having jumped to three spades on the first round, then announced a second suit. The fact is, of course, that South had nothing resembling a jump takeout of the notrump, even though this particular bid is not in the same strength-showing class as the jump takeout of an opening suit bid. In other words, when responder jumps to three of any suit over his partner's notrump, he is merely saying that he has substantially better than a two heart two spade, two diamond or two club takeout, and that he wants to get to game, whereas a jump response to an opening suit bid has strong slam implications. Even so, however, South should have been quite satisfied to bid only two spades!

West opened the diamond five; winning with the blank king, South led a spade toward dummy and was lucky to find West with the ace. West put up that card and exited with the spade. South now ruffed a low diamond and hopefully ruffed a spade with dummy's heart eight. Again he was lucky—spades broke. Now, however, when he led the ace and deuce of hearts, East put up the heart jack and West showed out when South took the trick.

There was only one way to keep East from making two trump tricks and South took that way. He led a club to the king, cashed the diamond ace for a spade discard, then led a diamond. East could not do better than to discard a club. South ruffed this trick with the trump seven, then led his last club to dummy. Now when he led from the dummy, East, with the Q-9 of trumps against South's blank ten of trumps, could not keep South from making the ten-spot for his fulfilling trick.
