**New Evidence Of Super Cave Man**  
NEW YORK (AP)—A University of Chicago anthropologist said Thursday new evidence suggests the prehistoric existence of a cave man "more advanced" than the famed Neanderthal man.

Addressing an assemblage of scientists observing the centennial of the discovery of Europe's Neanderthal—said by many anthropologists to have been more nearly allied to modern man than any other man-like creature—Dr. F. Clark Howell said recent studies suggest that "Palestinian man" rates that accolade.

He held a special symposium of the American Association for the Advancement of Science that when "Palestinian man" first was discovered 25 years ago, anthropologists thought the fossilized skeletons were remains of a species of man-like creature that had lived during the last "interglacial" age.

But he said a recent evaluation of the fossilized skeletons—found in four Palestinian caves—indicates that this species lived tens of thousands of years later, and was broadly contemporaneous with the Neanderthal man of Europe, although "more advanced" on the man-like scale.

He said the new evidence includes more precise "dating" of the fossils by means of their content of radioactive carbon. Howell estimated that "Palestinian" lived some 75,000 years ago.

PERTH, Scotland (Reuters) — Gordon James Fleming, 24, was jailed for six months here Wednesday after engaging with police in a 60-mile-an-hour road race, which continued for about 10 minutes after one of his car's tires blew off. Fleming ignored the dropped wheel and raced on in a shower of sparks for 10 miles before finally crashing.

TORONTO (CP)—Western oils sparked the stock market Friday to its strongest advance in more than two weeks as a buying spree in the final few minutes lifted the market. The market opened slightly higher with western oils showing strong but scattered gains. At noon the advance took a breather but it resumed an hour later with western oils still in the lead.

The western oil index climbed three points, base metals added 1 1/2 index points each. It was the best advance since Dec. 13 for the market as a whole and the biggest climb made by western oils since Dec. 3.
